Grammar Unit 2:

Present Simple Tense

Uses:

- **1. Habitual actions or routines,** We **go** to school from Monday to Friday.
- **2. Facts,**The moon **rotates** around the Earth.
- **3. Timetables,** The plane **leaves** at 5 p.m.
- 4. Likes/dislikes or opinions.
 I like chocolate very much. In fact, I love it!

Structures:

(+) Subject + VERB IN PRESENT + complements

I do my homework every day.

Special points:

1. If the subject is HE / SHE / IT, we add -s to the verb: work / works

My parents work in a supermarket.

My mum work<mark>s</mark> in a bank.

2. If the subject is HE / SHE / IT, we add -es to the following verbs endings:

```
-sh wash washes
-ch watch watches
-ss miss misses
-x mix mixes
-0 go goes
```

3. -Y ending:

4. If the verb finishes in -e, we only add -s.

```
danc<mark>e</mark> / danc<mark>es</mark>
```

DO NOT = DON'T

DOES NOT = DOESN'T

TIME MARKERS:

Frequency adverbs:

Always sempre

Usually normalment

Often sovint

Sometimes de vegades **Hardly ever** gairebé mai

Never mai

Position:

We place these adverbs **before the verb** but if it is the **verb to be after**.

I always do my homework.

I am always happy.

Other time expressions:

Every ... week cada ... setmana

monthmesyearanyclassclasse

Monday (weekdays) dilluns (dies de la setmana)

(...)

Once a ... week un cop / una vegada a la setmana

month al mes year a l'any

(...)

Twice a ... week month vear **(...)**

dos cops / dues vegades a la setmana al mes a l'any

a la setmana

al mes

a l'any

Three, four, ... times a day tres, quatre, cops al dia week month year **(...)**

On Monday, Tuesday, (...) weekdays: els dies de la setmana.

Position:

We place these time expressions at the end of the sentence or, occasionally, at the beginning with comma.

I do my homework every day.

She does aerobics on Tuesday and Friday.

He is tired every day.

On Tuesday and Friday, he plays tennis with his friends.

Every Sunday, we have lunch at my grandparents' house.

Once a year, the dentist checks my teeth.

EXAMPLES:

- (+) Your cousins make delicious pizzas every month.
- () Your cousins don't make delicious pizzas every month.
- (?) Do your cousins make delicious pizzas every month? Yes, they do / No, they don't.
- (?) What do your cousins make every month? ... pizzas.
- (?) When do your cousins make delicious pizzas?... every month.

He / She / It

3rd person singular

- (+) My father works in a bank every day.
- () My father doesn't work in a bank.
- (?) Does your father work in a bank? Yes, she does / No, she doesn't.
- (?) Where does your father work every day? ... in a bank.
- (?) When does your father work in a bank? ... every day.
